TUITION INFORMATION



- Due by the **7th** of each month
- Your monthly payments cover the amount of lessons provided per year, not per month. All students are expected to continue lessons during the summer months. Summer piano students have first choice when scheduling their lessons for the school year.
- Book fees are added to your account and charged at the same times as the current month's payment. You will be notified of the fee in advance and as needed
- Forms of payment accepted: cash, check (made payable to B Major Piano Studio), invoice via Quickbooks, and online at www.bmajorpianostudio.com
- A late fee of **\$30** will automatically be applied if tuition is not received past the 7th. Your lesson slot will be suspended if tuition is not received by the 10th
- Should something come up where you cannot financially fulfill your commitment to your lessons, advanced notice and open, ongoing communication is appreciated and encouraged!

MAKEUP LESSONS & MASTER CLASSES



~ Due to limited availability, the studio will not be able to offer Makeup Lessons. However, there are alternatives!

* **Master Class**- held twice per semester (makeup lessons are not given for Master Class)

* **Video Lessons**- the student sends a video to the instructor playing the songs they are currently working on and the instructor provides feedback (via video)

~ Students age 7 and up who are mildly ill may request an online lesson via Zoom during their regular time. Please notify the teacher well in advance

~ If the Teacher Must Cancel Lessons (this happens very rarely), students will be offered group lessons to make up for the missed lesson(s), or tuition may be prorated.

~ Students who are ill **SHOULD NOT** attend lessons. If you are too sick to attend school, you are too sick to attend your lesson. Please notify the teacher by 12pm if you cannot attend.

~ Students age 7 and up who are mildly ill may request an online lesson during their regular time.
